

**Team Salhouse report to Salhouse Parish Council meeting  
11<sup>th</sup> March 2024**

Since our last report to Parish Council in February, Team Salhouse volunteers are continuing to work around the village.

- The newly planted flower beds are receiving occasional attention.
- Litter picking has continued on an individual basis.
- A number of discarded vapes have been located on Bell Lane close to the Church. These needed to be disposed of carefully at a recycling centre as they contain Lithium batteries. There is a call to ban the sale of disposable vapes mainly for the reason of disposal problems.
- The mild and relatively wet winter has left the grass verges quite soft and we would urge drivers to try and avoid parking on them, especially close to the school, as the grass is easily damaged and the mud left behind could cause pedestrians to slip as well as becoming an eyesore.
