

**Team Salhouse report to Salhouse Parish Council meeting
8th April 2024**

Since our last report to Parish Council in March, Team Salhouse volunteers are continuing to work around the village.

- The newly planted flower beds are receiving occasional attention.
- Litter picking has continued on an individual basis
- The mild and relatively wet winter has left the grass verges quite soft and we would urge drivers to try and avoid parking on them, especially close to the school, as the grass is easily damaged and the mud left behind could cause pedestrians to slip as well as becoming an eyesore.
- We would ask the Parish Council if they could arrange to have the grass areas at the roundabout, the Village sign and the Upper Street/Lower Street junction cut regularly (fortnightly would be ideal) so that residents and visitors can appreciate the planted flower beds.
